Science Alive! has Health and Safety policies defined and an OSH committee monitoring all issues relating to Health and Safety.

Risk	Action Proposed / Responsibility
Vertical Slide (Friction burns)	Guidelines and safety procedures will be advised & followed Suitable clothing to be worn Only trained staff permitted to operate No more than 2 people at a time are to go down, and if 2 go down, one must have had previous experience
Lost Children	Guidelines will be advised & followed Supervision of young children Notification of caregivers required onsite
Fire in the building	On arrival the groups will be given the fire and evacuation procedures
Terrazzo Flooring Interactive Area Main Foyer	No running Wearing of shoes
Climbing wall Kidz Zone	Provision of safety mats Very young children need to be supervised Safety signage
Human Gyroscope	Guidelines will be advised & followed Only trained staff to operate Secure fencing during operation Safety Signage
Large Permanent Climbing Wall	Orientation for each user Only trained staff permitted to operate Staff managed visitor experience (*) Signage about safety procedures
Rear Car Park	Groups are notified of traffic dangers and students personal safety if using the car park at the rear of the building Group leaders supervise the students departure
Council Park	Group leaders are made aware of traffic and other hazards at the park if the groups are using it for a break
Electrical Equipment, Cords and Outlets	Young children need to be supervised at all times
